At approximately 3:26 p.m. on Tuesday, November 3, 2015, Oswego Police were notified by School District 308 that an 11 year old autistic male was missing in the area of Treasure Drive and **Blue Ridge Drive**.

Officers responded and conducted an immediate search of the area however the boy was not found. Oswego Police established a command post at Oswego East High School in order to organize a search with the assistance of neighboring agencies. Notifications were sent out to the public via the Everbridge Mass Notification System and the Department's Facebook page. Numerous tips were received from Village residents reporting seeing a subject meeting the boy's description. At approximately 5:58 p.m., the boy was found in the 2400 block of Wilson Creek Circle in Aurora due to information received from Oswego and Aurora residents who had received the Everbridge Mass Notification.

Due to the incident involving a high risk missing child, Oswego Police requested equipment and personnel from numerous agencies and would like to thank the following for their assistance:
